

Animal Poetry

Acrostic Poems are poems where the first letter of every line spells out the subject of the poem. Pick an animal and write an Acrostic Poem about it. Consider where your animal lives, how it acts, what it eats, and what it looks like.

For example:

Lying in the long, brown grass
It's silent as it hunts,
Overhead the white clouds pass
Now it's time for lunch.

Decorate your animal poems with drawings of the animal.
